



## June Blooms At the Crosby Arboretum!

### In and Around the Bog

Common Name	Species	Structure of Interest
Parrot Pitcher Plant	<i>Sarracenia psittacina</i>	Solitary, red, nodding flowers. Leaves laying along the surface of the ground, green with red veins.
Orange Candyroot	<i>Polygala lutea</i>	Small plant with flower clusters consisting of small orange flowers.
Short Milkwort	<i>Polygala ramosa</i>	Small, yellow flowers in a flat-topped cluster.
Sundew	<i>Drosera brevifolia</i>	Small, red-leaf plants with glandular hairs. Flowers solitary and pinkish white.
Meadow Beauty	<i>Rhexia mariana</i>	Upright plants with light pink flowers and long, bent stamens (yellow) in the center.
Yellow Rhexia	<i>Rhexia lutea</i>	Upright plants with yellow flowers and long stamens that point upwards.
Colic Root	<i>Aletris lutea</i>	Yellow, bell-shaped flowers in tall clusters.
Gold-Crest	<i>Lophiola americana</i>	Whitish plants with small yellow 'hairy' flowers.
Milkweed	<i>Asclepias lanceolata</i>	Small orange to reddish orange flowers in flat-topped clusters.
White-topped Sedge	<i>Dichromena colorata</i>	White flowers with drooping 'petals'. Resembles a lily.

### In and Around Beaver Pond

Common Name	Species	Structure of Interest
Water Lily	<i>Nymphaea odorata</i>	Aquatic plant with white many-petaled flowers. Numerous yellow stamens are found in the centers.
Cow Lily	<i>Nuphar luteum</i>	Aquatic plant with yellow, globular flowers.
Titi	<i>Cyrilla racemiflora</i>	Shrub to small tree. Drooping flower clusters with small, white flowers.

Pickerelweed	<i>Pontederia cordata</i>	Aquatic plant with solitary flower clusters with small blue flowers marked with yellow.
Lizard's Tail	<i>Saururus cernuus</i>	Aquatic plant; upright with a long, drooping cluster of white flowers; sepals and petals absent; long, white stamens.
Southern Magnolia	<i>Magnolia grandiflora</i>	Large dark, green leaves with reddish hairs on the undersides. Flowers white, showy and very fragrant.
Sweetbay Magnolia	<i>Magnolia virginiana</i>	Pale green leaves with white to silvery hairs on the undersides. Bark light gray to whitish. Flowers similar to <i>M. grandiflora</i> but smaller.
Red Bay & Swamp Bay	<i>Persea</i> spp.	Small tree with often mis-shapen leaves due to galls. Leaves aromatic. Small, yellow flowers in axillary clusters.
